Submitted papers must not have been previously published in or under consideration for publication in another journal or conference. The FCN 2025 organizing committee reserves the right not to review papers that either exceed the length limit or have been submitted or published elsewhere. All accepted papers must be presented onsite at the conference. Accepted papers will be submitted for inclusion into IEEE Xplore and then indexed by EI Compendex.
